

CLARIFICATION OF THE MEANING OF “GIVEN AT W. K. KELLOGG BIOLOGICAL STATION”  
IN THE DESCRIPTIONS OF COURSES

Excerpt from the minutes of the University Committee on Curriculum meeting of December 2, 1982, page 4:

5. Report of Subcommittee D - Policy Issues
  - b. Clarification of the Meaning of “Given at W. K. Kellogg Biological Station” in the Descriptions of Courses
    - (1) Chairperson Schechter reported that:
      - (a) the College of Natural Science had requested an interpretation of the meaning of “Given at W. K. Kellogg Biological Station” in the event that questions might arise when departments tried to schedule courses in other off campus nature centers.
      - (b) the members of Subcommittee D reviewed the action taken by Subcommittee A on November 4, 1982 (refer to paragraph 3 of the covering memorandum of the Report of Subcommittee A to the UCC dated December 2, 1982). They agreed with Subcommittee A’s position that a course for which “Given at W. K. Kellogg Biological Station” is part of the catalog statement may be taught at other off campus nature centers at the discretion of the department and without explicit UCC approval to teach the course in other locations.
