If you submit the essay late, your grade will be deducted accordingly. <u>Students participating</u> in <u>co-sponsored programs are subject to the grading scales and academic expectations of their host institutions</u>.

Cambridge has its fine academic reputation for a reason, so you may find the courses and grading more difficult than MSU. Be prepared to meet the academic standards of your host institution and the grading scale that it uses.
