Course load

DTU uses the European Credit Transfer System or ECTS. One ECTS credit is normally interpreted as approximately .5 of a U.S. semester credit. As DTU states a full course load to be 60 credits per year (A full course load at a Danish school is between 25-30 ECTS credits per semester. Exchange students may take a maximum of 35 ECTS credits per semester; this is the equivalent of between 12-17 MSU credits. Students typically take 5-6 courses per semester.

^{***} The credits are rounded up if there is a **single course with a decimal number of credits (i.e., 2.5 DTU credits = 3 MSU credits)**. However, if there is an even number of courses, the actual amount of credits is given for each course (i.e., two 2.5 credit DTU courses = 5 MSU credits). If there is an odd number of courses, the "extra" course earns the rounded up credits.
